Govt receives 552 complaints

Manama

Information Minister Ali bin Mohammed Al Rumaihi said the government had addressed 552 complaints received in the first six months of 2016 through the e-monitoring system dedicated to following up on citizens' complaints and remarks.

The minister said more than 50 per cent of the complaints were related to service provided. Administrative remarks, humanitarian appeals and economic, political and security complaints were also received. He commented that the e-monitoring system enables every ministry and government institution to measure the level of criticism levelled against them and address the issue.

The electronic system was introduced in line with the directives of Prime Minister HRH Prince Khalifa bin Salman Al Khalifa to maintain communication with the media in following up citizens' complaints and remarks.
